Thank you for your letter of 6 September 2024 and the NRC's statutory review of the Water Sharing Plan for the Murrumbidgee Regulated River Water Source 2016 (the plan), in line with Section 43A of the Water Management Act 2000.

The NRC review report for Murrumbidgee Regulated water sharing plan recommends that the plan is replaced, supported by the completion of the recommendations of this review. Noting, the opportunities for improvement identified, including:

- environmental water rules in the Plan and protections for environmental water
- changes to the allocations framework to improve equity and manage water availability where supply shortfalls occur
- modelling used in water management decision-making
- revision of the Long-Term Average Annual Extraction Limits (LTAAELs) to ensure these represent a sustainable level of extraction with greater transparency and use of actual extraction data in the assessment against extraction limits
- the Plan's outcomes for Aboriginal water users and communities.

The Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water (DCCEEW) will further consider these recommendations as part of the replacement of this plan and engage with the NRC as agreed at an officer level throughout this process.
